7 Iki Dolphin Park & Resort
 Enjoy interactive experiences with bottlenose dolphins in this Oceanside park. You can also enjoy fluffy pancakes and coffee at the onsite café.
 [Iki Dolphin Park & Resort]
 Admission: Adults, ¥1,000; junior high school and younger, ¥500

48 Morotsu Kannon Statue
 This park is known for its 9 meter tall, stone-carved statue of Kannon (Goddess of Mercy) and for being an excellent spot to see cherry blossoms.



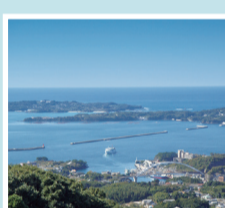
50 Tatsunoshima Jagatani
 The cliffs of this uninhabited island are famous for their striking striped appearance. View them up close from the Tatsunoshima Sightseeing Cruise.



1 Saruiwa (Monkey Rock)
 Over 45 meters tall, this striking, natural rock formation is famous for its remarkable resemblance to a monkey. There is a souvenir shop that sells local goods in the adjacent parking lot.



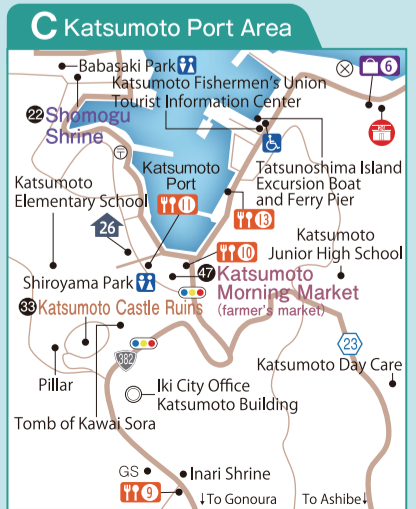
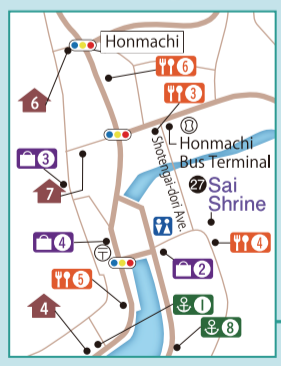
9 Oni-no-Ashiato (The Devil's Footprint)
 According to local legend, this enormous cave with a circumference of 110 meters was left when a large demon stepped on the island.



11 Takenotsuji Observation Platform
 This observation platform is located atop the island's tallest peak (212.8 meters) and offers beautiful panoramic views of Iki.

41 Shoni Park
 (Iki Shrine, Tomb of Shoni Suketoki and Stone Anchor from the Mongol Invasions)
 This scenic oceanside park and campground today has a calming atmosphere, but was actually the site of the second Mongol Invasion of Iki in 1281. Enjoy the park's barbecue area - see the other mongol invasion historic sights (Iki Shrine, anchor stone, tomb of Shoni Suketoki) nearby.



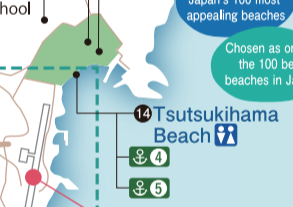
10 Sakyobana (Cape)
 This scenic seaside park is known for beautiful cliffs that stretch over a kilometer. A basalt pillar juts out of the ocean just off the coast here - according to Japanese myth it is one of 8 sacred pillars that holds the island in place.



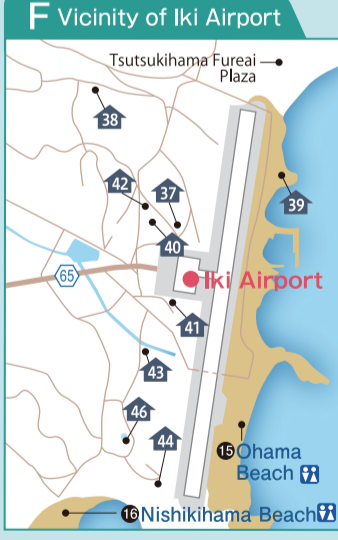
3 Harahoge Jizo
 During high tide these 6 Jizo statues become submerged to their chests. They get their name for the unique hole (hoge) in their stomachs (hara).
